

# 2005 ABBOTT REGULATIONS INTENSIVE

**Date: Thursday January 27, 2005**

The landmark Abbott v. Burke remedies are implemented through regulations adopted by the Commissioner of Education. Since 2003, the Abbott regulations are re-adopted every year as required by the State Legislature.

On November 30, 2004, Commissioner William Librera adopted the Abbott regulations for 2005. The rules spell-out the responsibilities of the NJ Department of Education and the Abbott districts and schools for implementing the Abbott programs and reforms. The rules guide such critical areas as: curriculum and instruction; professional development for teachers; supports for students and parents; school leadership teams; and opportunities for parent and community involvement.

Education Law Center will present a two-hour intensive session on the 2005 Abbott regulations, highlighting new initiatives, critical issues, and areas of concern.

The session is designed for coordinators and trainers, education organization staff, advocates and others who work with parents, teachers and community leaders in their districts to promote education improvement.
